GLOBAL STOCK INDEX

<p><u>DJIA</u></p>	<p>The Dow Jones Industrial Average and the S&P 500 posted record closing highs on Wednesday helped by a big jump in Walt Disney shares, but the Nasdaq fell as stocks were kept in check by fresh uncertainty over U.S.-China trade relations.</p> <p>The Wall Street Journal reported during the session that U.S.-China trade negotiations have hit a snag over farm purchases, the latest development in a dispute between the two countries that has convulsed markets for more than a year.</p> <p>The three indexes had all drifted higher earlier in the day after Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell said U.S. central bankers see a “sustained expansion” ahead for the country’s economy.</p> <p>Stocks have recently climbed to record levels, fueled by Fed interest rate cuts, third-quarter earnings exceeding low expectations and signs the economy is bottoming. But questions about an initial agreement to help resolve the U.S.-China trade dispute remain a key wild card.</p> <p>The Dow Jones Industrial Average rose 92.1 points, or 0.33%, to 27,783.59, the S&P 500 gained 2.2 points, or 0.07%, to 3,094.04 and the Nasdaq Composite dropped 3.99 points, or 0.05%, to 8,482.10.</p> <p>Among the S&P 500 sectors, traditionally defensive groups such as utilities, real estate and consumer staples ended sharply positive, while cyclical sectors, such as financials, energy and materials, which are known for tracking the health of the economy, lagged.</p> <p>Investors also had their eyes on geopolitical developments, including presidential impeachment hearings in the United States and protests in Hong Kong.</p> <p>Walt Disney Co shares jumped 7.3% after the media company said its new streaming service, Disney+, had reached 10 million sign-ups since launching the previous day. Disney shares provided the biggest boost to the Dow and the S&P 500.</p>
<p><u>Nikkei</u></p>	<p>Japanese shares slipped on Wednesday after a keenly awaited speech from U.S. President Donald Trump disappointed investors, offering few details on progress in trade talks with China.</p> <p>Chaos in Hong Kong also undermined sentiment as the city prepared for more clashes, with some transport links, schools and businesses closing after an escalation of violence.</p> <p>The Nikkei share average fell 0.85% to 23,319.87, having cooled since it hit an 13-month high of 23,591 on Friday. The broader Topix lost 0.55% to 1,700.33, ending a six-day winning streak.</p> <p>Trump on Tuesday dangled the prospect of completing an initial trade deal with China “soon”, but at the same time warned he would raise tariffs on Chinese goods “very substantially” if China does not strike a deal..</p> <p>Many market players have said a correction is inevitable after the Nikkei’s sharp rise of recent months - more than 17% up from its seven-month low marked in early August.</p> <p>Among blue chips, Nissan Motor slid 0.5% after the carmaker cut its full-year forecast to an 11-year low and posted a 70% slump in quarterly profit. Since the arrest of the firm’s former chairman Carlos Ghosn almost a year ago, the company has lost about 30% of value.</p> <p>Elsewhere, GMO Payment Gateway dropped 9.3% after the e-commerce settlement service company’s quarterly earnings and profit guidance for the year to next September fell short of market expectations. Fujifilm, on the other hand, jumped 6.3% after the firm reported strong quarterly earnings and estimated it would make a record annual profit.</p>
<p><u>Kospi</u></p>	<p>South Korean shares dropped on Wednesday as hopes for a Sino-US trade deal dwindled after President Donald Trump gave no new details on negotiations with China and as unrest in Hong Kong escalated.</p> <p>The Seoul stock market's main KOSPI index ended down 18.47 points, or 0.86 per cent, at 2,122.45. The benchmark index fell as much as 1 per cent in early trade, hitting the lowest since Nov 4.</p> <p>President Donald Trump on Tuesday dangled the prospect of completing an initial trade deal with China "soon," but offered no information on the negotiations in a campaign-style speech touting his administration's economic record.</p> <p>Trump's speech failed to meet market expectations, disappointing investors, said Park Sang-hyun, an analyst at HI Investment & Securities.</p> <p>Unrest in Hong Kong and a plunge in Hong Kong shares also affected local movement, he added.</p> <p>Foreigners were net sellers of US\$24.03 million worth of shares on the main board.</p> <p>The KOSPI has risen 3.99 per cent so far this year, and gained 4.4 per cent in the previous 30 trading sessions.</p> <p>The trading volume during the session in the KOSPI index was 655.80 million shares and, of the total traded issues of 905, the number of advancing shares was 282.</p>
	<p>➤ Hong Kong stocks dropped nearly 2% on Wednesday, led by declines in property shares, as protests spread across the city. Risk appetite was also curbed by fears that U.S.-China trade talks are not making progress.</p>

Hang Seng & Shanghai

The Hang Seng index fell 1.8% to end at 26,571.46, while the China Enterprises Index lost 1.6% to 10,519.12 points. The property sector tumbled 2.5%.

Anti-government protesters paralysed parts of the Asian financial hub for a third day, after the city's embattled leader, Carrie Lam, said protesters trying to paralyse the city were being "extremely selfish". Chinese state media condemned the violence, with the China Daily newspaper stating that young protesters were revelling in a "hormone-fuelled 'rebellion'".

The market is also clouded by uncertainty around the Sino-U.S. trade talks. U.S. President Donald Trump said a trade deal was "close" but gave no new details on when or where an agreement would be signed, disappointing investors in what was billed as a major speech on his administration's economic policies.

The sub-index of the Hang Seng tracking energy shares dipped 1.9%, while the IT sector dipped 0.82%, the financial sector ended 1.88% lower and the property sector dipped 2.52%. The top gainer on the Hang Seng was Sino Biopharmaceutical Ltd, which gained 0.89%, while the biggest loser was New World Development Co Ltd, which fell 4.91%. China's main Shanghai Composite index closed down 0.33% at 2,905.24 points, while the blue-chip CSI300 index ended down 0.09%.

➤ Shanghai stocks on Wednesday hit their lowest close in more than six weeks amid mixed signals over the extent of progress made in the U.S.-China trade talks, while an escalation of violence in Hong Kong rattled sentiment.

The blue-chip CSI300 index closed 0.1% lower at 3,899.98, while the Shanghai Composite Index ended down 0.3% at 2,905.24 points, its lowest close since Sept. 30.

U.S. President Donald Trump said that a trade deal was "close" but gave no new details on when or where an agreement would be signed, disappointing investors in what was billed as a major speech on his administration's economic policies.

Amid increasing pressure on the world's second-largest economy, Chinese Premier Li Keqiang said China should use counter-cyclical adjustment measures more effectively, and will improve the use of local government special bonds and strengthen support for the economy.

Rising political chaos in Hong Kong curbed risk appetite further as anti-government protesters paralysed parts of the Asian financial hub for a third day, Chinese state media condemned the violence, with the China Daily newspaper stating that young protesters were revelling in a "hormone-fuelled rebellion".
