GLOBAL STOCK INDEX

<p><u>DJIA</u></p>	<p>The benchmark S&P 500 stock index posted a slim gain to end with a record closing high on Thursday, as a dour forecast from tech stalwart Cisco Systems was offset by a strong report from big box retailer Walmart.</p> <p>The Dow index ended barely negative, after posting a closing high on Wednesday, while the Nasdaq also ended fractionally lower.</p> <p>Cisco shares tumbled 7.3% after the network gear maker forecast second-quarter revenue and profit below expectations as increasing global economic uncertainties kept clients away from spending more on its routers and switches.</p> <p>Cisco's share decline weighed the most on the major indexes and helped drag the technology sector .SPLRCT down 0.1%.</p> <p>In contrast, Walmart raised its annual outlook, and the world's largest retailer posted better-than-expected earnings, comparable sales and e-commerce growth in its largest market during the third quarter.</p> <p>Walmart shares fell 0.3% after hitting a record high earlier in the session, but the S&P 500 retail .SPXRT and consumer discretionary .SPLRCD indexes finished higher after the company's report.</p> <p>The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 1.63 points, or 0.01%, to 27,781.96, the S&P 500 gained 2.59 points, or 0.08%, to 3,096.63 and the Nasdaq Composite dropped 3.08 points, or 0.04%, to 8,479.02.</p> <p>Stocks have recently run to all-time highs, helped by the Federal Reserve's interest rate cuts, third-quarter earnings topping low expectations, and signs the economy may be bottoming.</p> <p>Third-quarter corporate reporting season is drawing to a close with about three-fourths of S&P 500 companies posting profits above expectations, but with earnings expected to have declined 0.4% overall from the year-earlier period, according to Refinitiv.</p>
<p><u>Nikkei</u></p>	<p>Japanese shares hit 1-1/2-week lows on Thursday after profit-taking set in as doubts over an interim U.S.-China trade deal grew, while Line Corp and Z Holdings jumped on news the Yahoo Japan operator was in merger talks with messaging app firm Line.</p> <p>The Nikkei share average retreated 0.8% to 23,141.55, its lowest since Nov. 5, and the broader Topix dropped 0.9% to 1,684.40, also a 1-1/2-week low.</p> <p>Dashing upbeat expectations about a phase one deal was a Wall Street Journal report that said Sino-U.S. negotiations had "hit a snag" over farm purchases, with Beijing not wanting a deal that looks one-sided in favour of the United States.</p> <p>Worries about violent anti-government protests in Hong Kong also soured investor sentiment.</p> <p>In the cautious climate, the safe-haven yen firmed as high as 108.66 overnight and was last quoted at 108.72 against the dollar, weighing on Japanese exporters as a strong domestic currency hurts corporate profits when they are repatriated.</p>
<p><u>Kospi</u></p>	<p>South Korean stocks ended higher on Thursday, boosted by a surge in Naver's shares, while investors shrugged off soft economic data from China. The Korean won and the benchmark bond yield rose.</p> <p>Web portal operator Naver's stock closed up nearly 14% to its highest since Feb. 2018, after Yahoo Japan confirmed it was in talks to merge with Naver's unit, Line Corp.</p> <p>Without a new momentum, Naver's significant gain contributed to the KOSPI's rise, said Lee Won, an analyst at Bookook Securities. The weak data from China had limited impact in local markets, Lee added.</p> <p>China's industrial output grew significantly slower than expected in October, as weakness in global and domestic demand and the drawn-out Sino-U.S. trade war weighed on activity in the world's second-largest economy.</p> <p>The Seoul stock market's main KOSPI closed up 16.78 points, or 0.79%, at 2,139.23.</p>
<p><u>Hang Seng & Shanghai</u></p>	<p>➤ Hong Kong shares fell to their lowest close in more than a month on Thursday as parts of the city remained paralysed by a fourth consecutive weekday of protests, and as a drop in index heavyweight Tencent dragged on the broader index.</p> <p>At the close of trade, the Hang Seng index was down 247.77 points, or 0.93%, at 26,323.69, its lowest close since Oct. 11. The Hang Seng China Enterprises index fell 0.87% to 10,427.38. Anti-government protesters paralysed parts of Hong Kong for a fourth day on Thursday, forcing school closures and blocking highways and other transport links to disrupt the financial hub amid a marked escalation of violence. The Hang Seng was weighed down by losses in index heavyweight Tencent Holdings Ltd, which dropped 2.32% after the gaming and social media company posted a surprise 13% drop in quarterly profit. A sub-index of the Hang Seng tracking the IT sector fell 1.68%. The falls come despite Alibaba Group launching the share sale for its Hong Kong listing on Wednesday, in what is seen as a boost for</p>

the city. The sub-index of the Hang Seng tracking energy shares dipped 1.2%, the financial sector ended 0.83% lower and the property sector dipped 1.03%. The top gainer on the Hang Seng was AAC Technologies Holdings Inc, which gained 3.71%, while the biggest loser was Tencent Holdings Ltd, which fell 2.32%. China's main Shanghai Composite index closed up 0.16% at 2,909.87, while the blue-chip CSI300 index ended up 0.15%.

➤ China shares rebounded from six-month lows to end higher on Thursday after data reflecting a sharper slowdown in industrial activity in October reinforced expectations that Beijing will introduce fresh measures to support economic growth.

At the close, the Shanghai Composite index was up 0.16% at 2,909.87. In the previous session, the index hit its lowest closing in more than six weeks. The blue-chip CSI300 index ended 0.15% firmer, with its financial sector sub-index lower by 0.3%, the consumer staples sector up 0.01%, the real estate index ended down 0.17% and the healthcare sub-index closed 1.51% higher. China's industrial production rose 4.7% year-on-year in October, significantly slower than expected on weakness in global and domestic demand, and as a drawn-out trade war with the United States weighed on activity. The smaller Shenzhen index ended up 0.61%, while the start-up board ChiNext Composite index closed higher by 0.642%. Shares in Shenzhen-listed Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Co Ltd fell 2.46% after the company said China's securities regulator was investigating two Hikvision directors for alleged violations of disclosure rules.
